ADMISSIONS PROCESS

1. Applications

Open 31 March 2020

Close 5 June 2020

Parents wishing to apply to send learners to Greytown High School should collect application forms between the two dates above.

2. Completed Applications

5 June 2020

Completed application forms must reach the school before Friday, the 5th June 2020.

- Please complete **Form A and Form B** neatly and accurately and return with learners latest school report and birth certificate
- Incomplete applications can not be processed.
- The **Confidential Report - Form C** must be submitted to the learners' current school for completion and they will sent it to Greytown High School. Form C must reach our office by 5 June 2020.
- Applications may be posted, handed in at the office or emailed to office@greytownhigh.co.za Should you email the application, you will be required to submit the original document for filing purposes.

The submission of the application form is not a guarantee that the learner will be awarded a place in the school.

3. Acknowledging Applications:

Form D with a reference number will be issued to you once your application is received. This letter is **not** proof of acceptance to the school.

- You will **not** receive further correspondence from us until after the Open Day.
- We are only able to accommodate a limited number of learners, **therefore it is ESSENTIAL THAT YOU ALSO APPLY (AS SOON AS POSSIBLE) TO OTHER SCHOOLS.**

4. Notification of Acceptance / Non-Acceptance

From the 20th to 22nd July 2020

Parents are emailed/phoned/will receive an sms, after the admission selection, to inform them of the committees decision regarding acceptance for school and/or boarding.

5. Open Day for Successful Applicants

Only successful candidates will be invited to attend the Open Day. It is **compulsory** for the learner and parent to attend the open day. Important information regarding the school is presented by the Principal at the Open Day. **Please be aware that should you and your child not attend the Open Day, it will be assumed that you no longer require the space approved for you. Registration forms will be handed to parents at the Open Day event.**

Friday, the 31 July 2020 from 10:00 to 14:00

OR

Saturday, the 1 August 2020 from 10:00 to 14:00

6. Registration

Friday, the 21st August 2020 from 09:00 to 12:00

OR

Saturday, the 22nd August 2020 from 08:00 to 11:00

Completed Registration Forms MUST be returned on one of the two above mentioned dates.

An **acceptance deposit** is payable to confirm your child's acceptance. For your budgeting purposes, please note the deposits payable for the 2021 intake :

- Day scholars - R200
- Boarders - R500

You will be required to bring copies of the following documents :

Enrolment at Greytown High School is only completed once all relevant forms are submitted and the acceptance deposit has been paid.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. School Fees

School Fees for 2020 are as follows :-

Day Scholars	Gr 8 – 12	R13 356.00 per annum
Boarding (including school fees)	Gr 8 – 12	R51 845.00 per annum

Please note that the fees for 2021 will increase. The increase will be determined at the Governing Body Meeting in October/November 2019. ***School fee reduction/exemption will NOT be considered for prospective applicants***

2. Other Expenses (to be paid by parents):

The following are NOT provided by the school and are NOT included in the tuition or boarding fees :

- School Uniforms and items for boarding
- Stationery
- Sports clothing, sports shoes and sports equipment
- School Tours and Camps
- Any other expenses that might arise

Uniform and stationery lists will be available at the school after acceptance.

Please ensure that you apply to more than one high school, as we are limited to the number of learners we are able to accommodate – both in the boarding establishment and the classrooms.
