Dear Parent/Guardian

We would like to thank all parents who made the Annual General Meeting a success on Monday, the 8th November 2021. There was a lot of optimism towards making Greytown High School an even better school. An increase of 6% was agreed upon by all present. School fees for 2022 will thus be R14 990 per annum at R1499 per month, payable over ten months. Hostel fees will be R58 220 per annum at R5822 per month, payable over ten months.

The school is in the process of auditing those parents who have not paid school fees and those who receive SASSA grants. You are required to update all your information with the school annually. Parents must reapply each year for school fees exemption. If it is found that anyone provided untruthful information to the school or claimed to be earning a SASSA grant in order to qualify for school fee exemption, they will be faced with charges of fraud. It is very important to note that the school only gets 32% of its budget from the State. We therefore urge parents to pay school fees timeously, as the school largely depends on it for its daily functioning.

The new parents' and teachers' association (PTA) was elected at the Annual General Meeting and the following parents are on the committee - Mr Nkululeko Mkhize (Chairman), Mrs Nontobeko Mkhize, Pastor Nkhoma and Mr Mduduzi Khoza. The main function of the PTA is to get parents more involved with the school and to help the school raise funds. Any other parents who may be interested in joining the association can contact the chairman, Mr Mkhize, via the school.

On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month, the school unveiled its Wall of Remembrance in the presence of some members of the Moth Club, staff and learners. This was in commemoration of Old Scholars who died in the war serving our country and Greytown High School learners and Old Scholars who have passed on over the years. Families of Old Scholars are welcome to contact the school to purchase plaques to be put up on the wall in remembrance of their loved ones.

Final exams are in full swing for all grades. We once again urge parents to ensure that your child gets adequate time to study and that you eliminate anything that may prove to be a distraction to your child's study time.
